Commentary As elsewhere in Europe, the import of Japanese lacquers, textiles, and porcelain left an important mark on potters in

Rouen. This dish is influenced by Japanese Imari porcelain, characterized by extensive floral motifs painted in radiant blue and iron-red, and gold, although the central scene likely derives from a Chinese model.
